Meeting Opening

The meeting was the fifteenth official meeting of the Intergenerational Trust Fund for the People of the Republic of Nauru (the Fund) and opened at 12:05pm with a prayer by Minister Kun.

Trust Fund Business

1. Approval of 26 November 2019 Meeting Minutes confirmed.

Decision: The Committee endorsed the minutes.

<u>Action:</u> Ms McPhee to sign required documentation and return to BDO for finalisation. (Please note this has been received by BDO since the meeting).

<u>Action:</u> Mr Lee to organise for Amb Ger to sign documentation and return to BDO for finalisation.

2. Financial Information

Decision: The Committee endorsed the financial information prepared by BDO.

3. Independent Consultant Report

Decision: The Committee endorsed the information included in Mr Hutton's Monitoring Paper.

4. Mercer Investment Information

<u>Decision:</u> The Committee endorsed the information included in the Investment Update prepared by Mercer.

Decision: The Committee agreed that information sessions were needed at the next meeting.

Action: Mr Hutton to provide a basic information session on finance fundamentals.

<u>Action:</u> Mr Maher to re-present the information that was provided to the Committee on the establishment of the Fund.

<u>Action:</u> Mr Maher to organise for Mr McCabe to attend the next meeting and provide a session on how the Fund's portfolio has been selected and the process that goes into the decision making.

<u>Action:</u> Mr Maher to forward the Cryptocurrency paper that Mercer prepared previously to the Committee.

<u>Action:</u> Mrs Griffin to forward the crypto-asset information prepared by BDO to the Committee.

<u>Action:</u> Mrs Griffin to liaise with Mr Hutton and Mr Maher in relation to the timing of each session and update the draft agenda for the next meeting accordingly.

5. Public Release

GON issued a public release on the valuation of the Fund in January 2020. Mr Petersen advised that it was planned to have an annual media release at this stage.

6. Other business

Action: Mr Petersen is to provide a letter for Mercer's records in for the additional \$1m.

Action: Mrs Griffin to update the budget to include the additional \$1m from ADB.

7. Future meetings

<u>Action:</u> Ms Griffin to tentatively pencil in the next Committee meeting on Tuesday 26th May 2020 in New Zealand and will liaise with Mr Griffith to confirm the details in due course.
