## **SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 2014-15**

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Supplementary Appropriation Bill (No. 9 2014-15) makes for one adjustment to the 2014-15 Budget estimates of expenditure to provide for events, which were unanticipated at the time the 2014-15 Budget, as well as items, which were not included in the Budget bills for various reasons.

The total expenditure in this Supplementary Budget amounts to **\$550,000** and is comprised of the following:

Presidency

\$550,000

This additional expenditure is affordable and been made available from reallocating unspent funds from Finance Other Payments. There will be no impact on overall budgeted revenue and expenditure and the modest surplus of \$409,558 remains unchanged after these changes.
