## **SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 2016-17**

### **O**VERVIEW

The Supplementary Appropriation Bill (No. 4 2016-17) provides for expenditures related to Salaries and Allowances for MPs and Salaries for Life Guards of the National Emergency Services.

Overall this Supplementary Appropriation will increase aggregate expenditure this year to an anticipated \$150,115 an increase of \$181,000 on the revised estimates. The deficit is expected to increase to \$6,364mill for the financial year. The deficit is to be funded from accumulated cash reserves.
