SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 2015-16

OVERVIEW

The Supplementary Appropriation Bill (No. 4 2015-16) makes a couple of adjustments to the 2015-16 Budget estimates of expenditure to provide for events, which were unanticipated at the time the 2015-16 Budget.

The total expenditure in this Supplementary Budget amounts to \$2,100,000 and is comprised of the following:

•	Ministerial	\$ 1,100,000
•	Foreign Affairs: NY	\$ 223,000
•	GON Warehouse	\$ 50,000
•	Health	\$ 727,000

In addition, \$509,562.45 is drawn from the Chief Secretariat budget and allocated to Departments salaries budget for the 8% salary increase.
