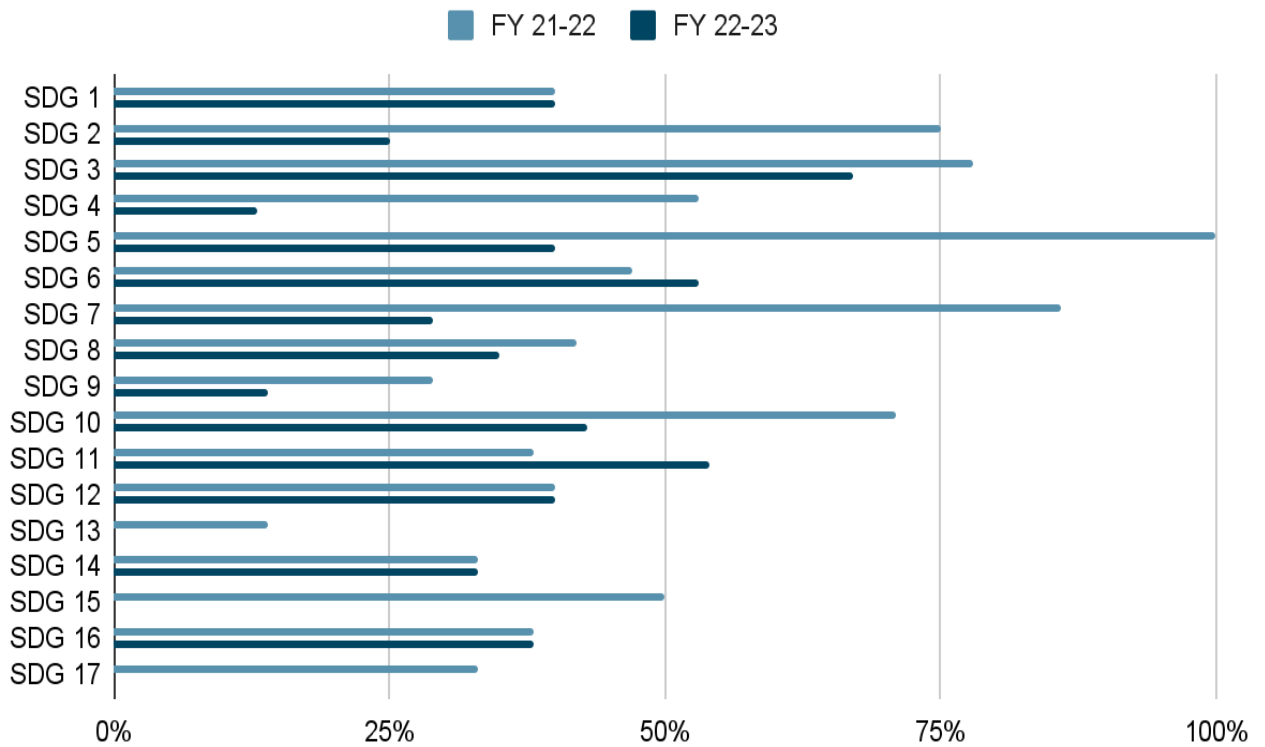

Worst Performing SDGs - SDG 15 and 17 (0%)



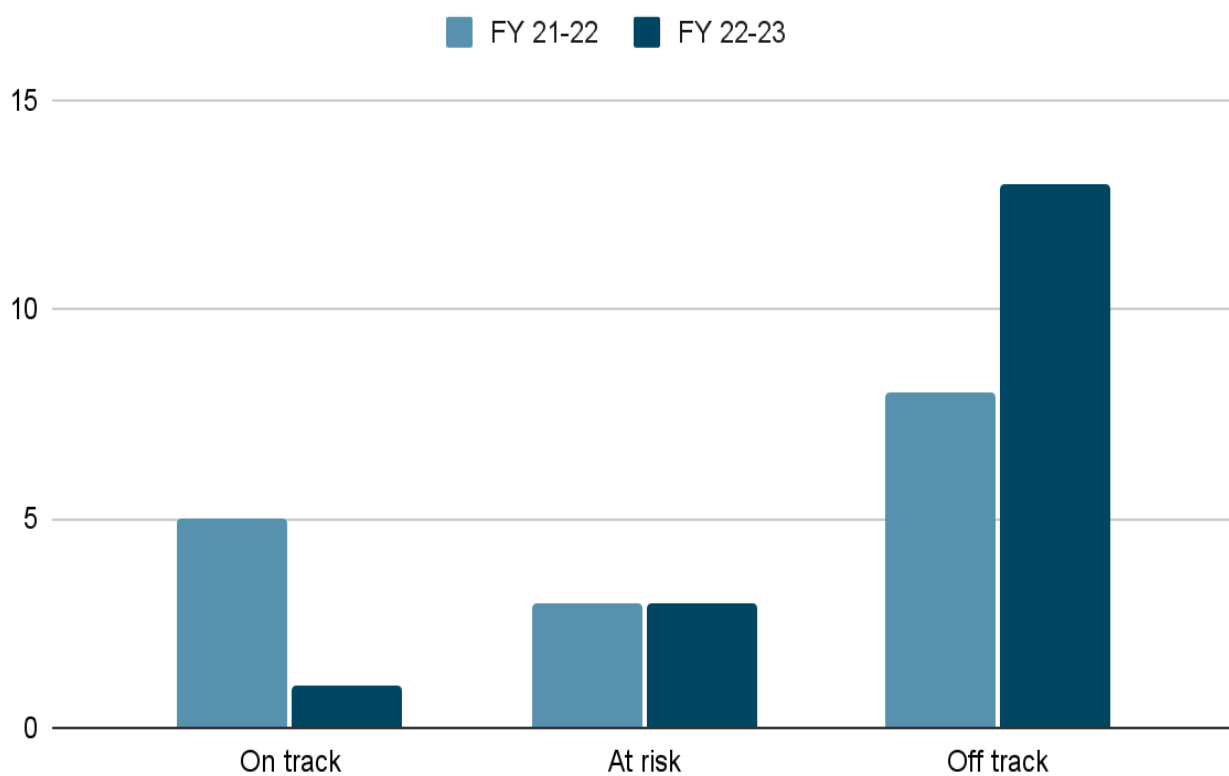
