SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION No.4 2024-25

OVERVIEW

Supplementary Appropriation Bill (No.4) 2024-25 recognise new revenue and appropriate these funds to cover new government expenditures.

This Supplementary recognises an additional revenue of \$5.4 million related to new RPC funding from the Government of Australia.

Of this revenue, \$1 million (or 18 percent) will be allocated toward costs of the new Department of Internal Affairs, which manages the operations related to receiving and hosting the new cohorts' transferees on island. The remaining balance of approximately \$4.4 million will be utilised for priority expenditure pressures of the Government.

At the passing of this Supplementary Appropriation Bill, the total revised budget balance will be \$0.2 million for the year.

The Supplementary also provides an opportunity to address a housekeeping matter relating to the recognition of the \$15 million first tranche budget support from the Government of Australia. The accounting entries will henceforth reflect both the receipt of the budget support into the treasury fund, and the appropriation and transfer of the entire contribution into the Trust Fund.

This Bill reflects updated expenditure estimates to:

- Recognise additional revenue
- Appropriate new expenditures
- Undertake a housekeeping matter relating to recognition of the Government of the Australia \$15 million tranche 1 budget support funds.

\$1 million is allocated to a new department of Internal Affairs to manage the administration and operations relating to the hosting of special cohort transferees from Australia NZYQ. NZYQ refers to a group of people who are released from immigration detention in Australia after a 2023 High Court decision.

Housekeeping Measures

In addition to the measures mentioned above, this Supplementary Appropriation Bill provides an opportunity to address a housekeeping matter to properly recognize the \$15 million budget support funds from the Government of Australia. The revenue was not properly accounted for in Supplementary Appropriation No 2, passed in December. The accounting entries will henceforth reflect both the receipt of the budget support into the treasury fund, and the appropriation and transfer of the entire contribution into the Trust Fund, leading to no impact on the overall budget balance.
